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CAREER PROFILE

I am a School Psychologist with over 33 years of experience in education and public service, and I am the recently retired director of Safety and Risk Management Services for the Salem-Keizer School District in Salem, Oregon. I am the principal author and architect of the Salem-Keizer Cascade Model, a threat assessment system that is being used in Oregon, Washington, and several other states throughout the country—and a system that is considered a gold standard by the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigations and the U.S. Department of Education. In addition to behavioral threat assessment, the model is now a comprehensive preventive assessment and safety planning system that includes suicide risk assessment and prevention, fire misbehavior assessment, and problematic sexual behavior assessment and management. I remain the primary resource on the fidelity, sustainability, and continued improvement of that model as it evolves within our changing culture and climate.

Through my years of experience, I have gained considerable institutional knowledge and a systems expertise that includes the interrelationships of public agency partnering, school discipline, special education, 504 law, administration and management, human resources, education culture, mental health, educational psychology, preventive behavioral threat assessment, suicide assessment and prevention, problematic sexual behavior, and extremely disruptive behavioral patterns. Additionally, I have considerable experience in physical security and operational security that includes CPTED (Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design), options-based decision-making/response to violent intruder training, emergency management and incident command, security training, de-escalation of aggressive people, and the management of adults who threaten or cause disruption in school settings.

I served as Chair of Oregon's Mid-Valley Student Threat Assessment Team from its inception in 2000 through 2015, and I continue to provide consultation to its membership. I have served as a member of the Marion County Threat Advisory Team since 1999. I am the editor and principal author of the book, *Assessing Student Threats: Implementing The Salem-Keizer System, Second Edition*.

I am now consulting with school districts and community agencies around the country, specializing in preventive behavioral threat assessment and school security. I regularly provide training and consultation to audiences nationally on preventing and mitigating human violence, physical and operational security, and response options for violent intruder and active shooter situations.
